Our **Virgil Family Health Center** was designed as a comforting oasis in a busy world – and we’ve provided **3,112 patient visits** since opening in April.

As resources became unavailable to unhoused individuals, we provided **5,930 showers** and passed out thousands of meals, sleeping bags, masks, toiletry kits, and other essentials.

To protect every patient and staff member, we spent more than **\$650k on safety measures** including PPE, masks, and sanitizers.

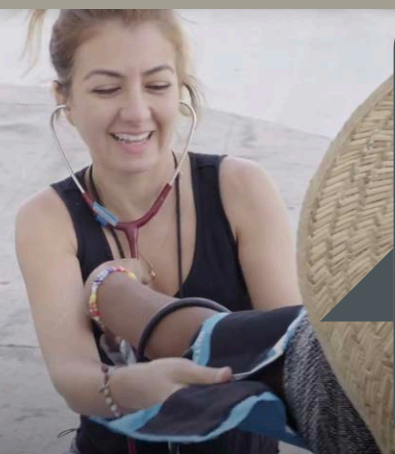
